**Fall 2014 Poetry Writing Workshop** — All levels are welcome to join in this six-session, bi-monthly workshop. We'll begin each three-hour segment with a focused exploration of a particular aspect of poetry writing, supported by selected readings of essay excerpts provided beforehand, as well as model poems provided at the time of the workshop. Following discussion, participants will write for 15–20 minutes from a menu of related prompts, with the last two hours dedicated to reading and discussing work submitted in the previous session. Revisions will be encouraged.
